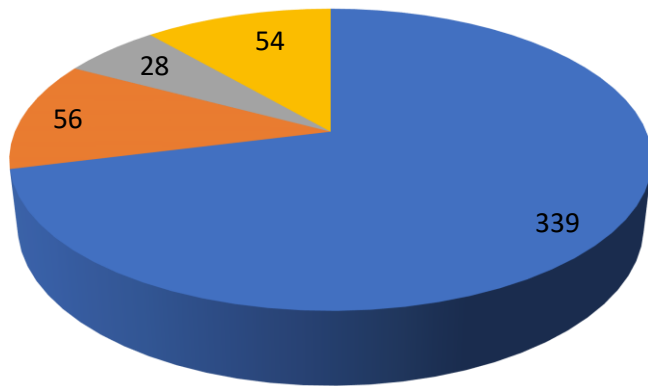

## Hill of Fare Wind Farm Questionnaire

RES, in partnership with Dunecht Estates, proposes to install a wind farm on the summit plateau of the Hill of Fare. A detailed scoping report for this project has been prepared by RES and can be viewed online at <http://www.hilloffare-windfarm.co.uk/>

The purpose of this questionnaire is to enable the adjacent Community Councils to accurately represent the views of the community. If you live outside our CC area we will pass your completed questionnaire on to your own Community Council.

A very important element of the proposal will be its impact on the landscape. The turbines will be 250 metres (820 feet) high to the blade tip. As a comparison, the towers of the Queensferry Crossing are 207 metres high. Imagine 17 turbines of this height on top of the Hill of Fare, which itself rises 350m above Echt. There will also be a need for new pylons to connect to the grid, a network of roads on the hill and the battery compound.

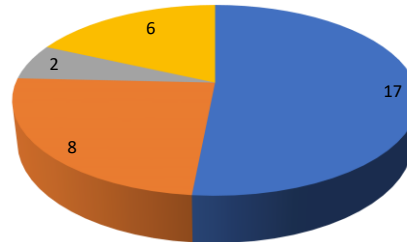

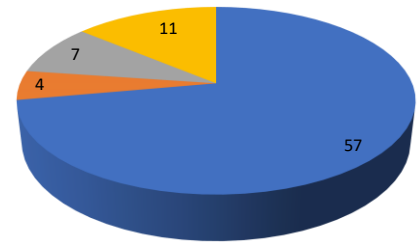
