Call for NOMINATIONS for COMMUNITY COUNCILLORS

Crathes, Drumoak & Durris Community Council is required to hold elections for the membership of the Community Council for the cycle 2017 – 2020.

We therefore call upon persons who wish to become Community Councillors and who are aged 18 years or over and either:

- a) appear on the Electoral Roll for that Community Council area at the date of being proposed for membership of the Community Council; or
- b) have during a period of at least three months preceding the date of nomination had their ordinary or principal place of residence within the Community Council area; or
- c) are the owner of a business located in a Community Council Area, although not personally resident there

to submit a nomination form, signed by a proposer and seconder (who must also be resident within the community).

Forms are available on our website and should be submitted by latest **6th December 2017** as detailed on the form.

Community Councils are voluntary organisations and form a vital link between local government and communities, giving a voice to local residents and helping to decide on the type of place we want to live in.
